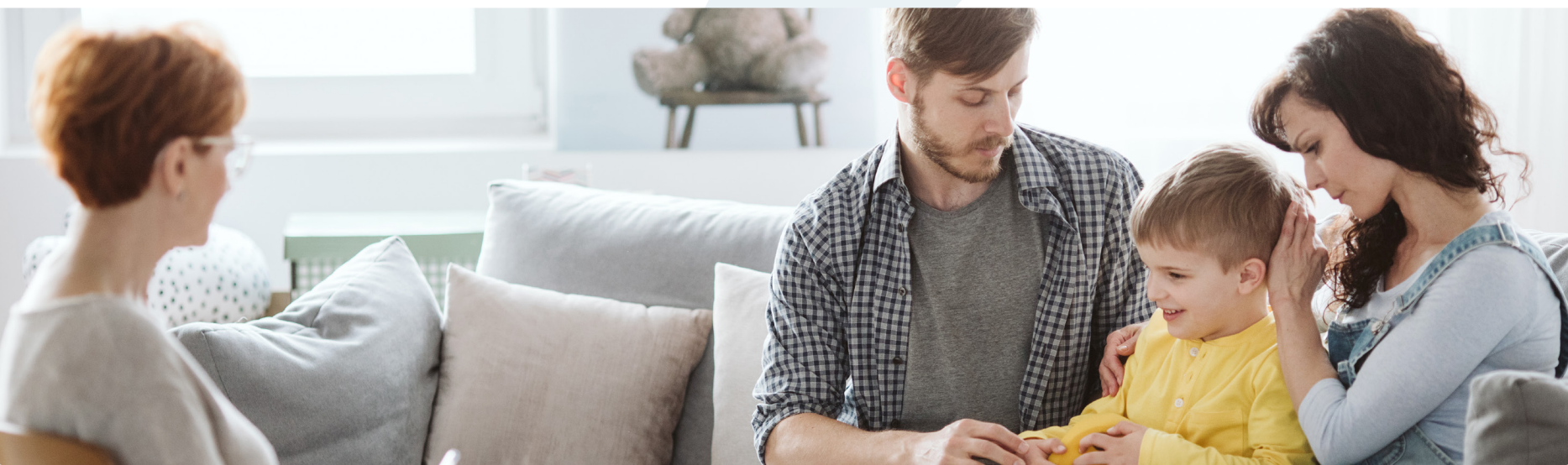
You Don't Have to Handle It Alone
